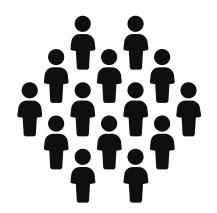



- 19,000Missing people with TB (2,776 were children)
- 5,700 people died because of TB
- 484 Laboratory confirmed people with MDR/RR-TB (WHO data, 2020)
