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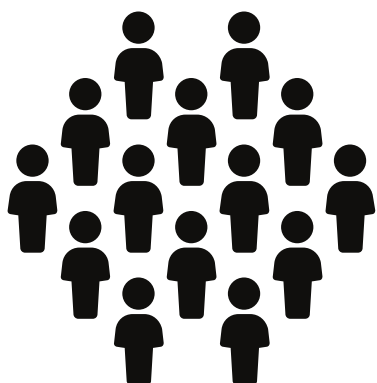

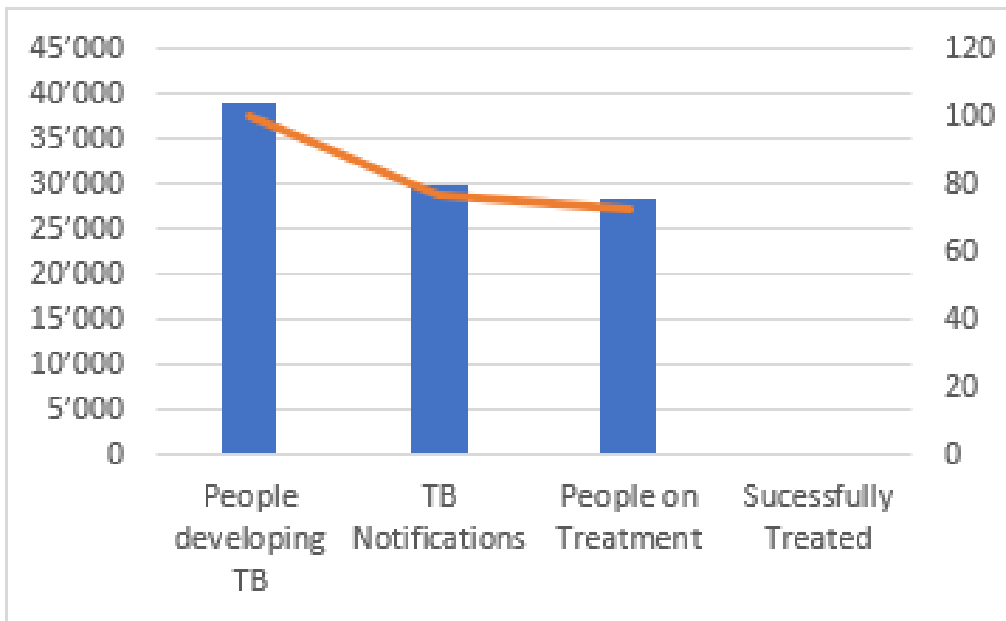

- **4,300** people died because of TB
- **593** Laboratory confirmed people with MDR/RR-TB (WHO data, 2020)
